## WRITING

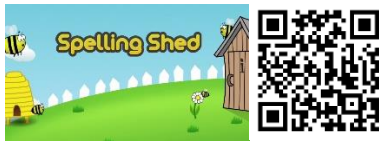
Practise one each of the Year 3 Exciting Sentences. (These sentences are in your pack.) You could write a diary entry of based around your time off.
