1) School Improvement Priorities (Ofsted Action Plan) MN explained that we continue to work on School Development priorities that link to our Action Plan following Ofsted. MN explained that we are utilising TPAT support for Subject Leaders to continue to develop their subjects. As per last meeting, we continue to focus on Curriculum development. All subjects will have been monitored over a half term by the end of July. Governors have also been updated and been part of monitoring for these subjects. The same monitoring process is now built into the school calendar for each academic year. Primary Executive Lead (PEL) for TPAT stated (in relation to British Values): Some of the best pupil voice responses on British values that I have ever heard! Real impact in this area already! This was following the Spring Term visit on 1 st March, 2023. At that time, we had only been working on this priority (discussed in whole school assemblies, class assemblies and links to curriculum subjects where appropriate) for 7 weeks. In the Summer Term, children will be presenting to Governors about this (British Values).	MN to arrange children to speak to Governors (possibly Year 6, post SATS).
